Tax Credit Program Highlights: Certified Projects

While many of the projects are full-building rehabs, the state program also allows property owners to complete smaller upgrade or maintenance projects, some of which include the Menger Hotel and L.T. Wright House in San Antonio and the Fred Schimelpfenig Building in Plano. The state program, unlike the Federal Rehabilitation Tax Credit, is also available to non-profit owners, represented by projects such as the First National Bank of Port Arthur, the Whiskey Warehouse, and the Neill-Cochran House.
