Did You Know?

Texas Agriculture Commissioner Sid Miller has announced the second annual Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) Farm Fresh Challenge, hosted by the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA), to bring healthy foods to tables across the country for children in participating child care centers, home day care and afterschool programs, as well as adults in day care centers. Texas CACFP providers serve about 350,000 meals each day in more than 13,000 child care centers and day care homes, and about 50,000 meals a day in more than 400 adult day care centers.
