Central Texas Highlights



A&M-Central Texas has received \$1,318,324 authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. Half of the federal allocation – \$659,162 – will directly support emergency aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of regular university operations due to COVID-19. The remaining one half of the funds help address expenses to the institution related to COVID19, including increased technology costs and health and safety precautionary measures.

Texas Water Development Board Solicitations

The Executive Administrator of the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) is seeking nominations for individuals to serve as members of the 15 inaugural regional flood planning groups. The Executive Administrator will evaluate nominations and recommend up to 180 individuals to the Board for its consideration. These planning groups will be responsible for developing Texas' first regional flood plans by January 2023, which will culminate in the state's first-ever state flood plan. The ideal candidate will have experience in and a continued strong interest in working cooperatively on public issues; be committed to and possess expertise in flood risk-related issues; be strongly affiliated with and endorsed by the interest category for which they are nominated, and be capable of playing a leadership role in a regional flood planning group.
