Emergency Rural Health Care Grant Program

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) provides the Rural Housing Service Community Facilities (CF) Program up to \$500 million in grant funding for eligible applicants and eligible facilities to help broaden access to COVID-19 testing and vaccines, health care services including telehealth services, food assistance through food banks and food distribution facilities, and collaborative, evidence -based support for the long-term sustainability of rural health care. <u>Click Here!</u> To learn more.
