Connected Nation Community Action Plan for Lampasas and San Saba Counties

A Technology Action Plan developed by Connected Nation Texas (CN Texas) has been presented to both Lampasas and San Saba counties following a broadband survey. Residents took part in a survey designed to determine the availability of internet infrastructure; how they are adopting and using broadband services; and what steps would have the greatest impact toward improving broadband access, adoption, and use across local community sectors. The feedback from residents, business owners, and community leaders played an integral role in the development of the Technology Action Plan. The recommended broadband goals for both counties are to:

- Improve healthcare in Lampasas and San Saba counties by increasing telehealth services and expanding access to medical assistance
- Increase online engagement in Lampasas and San Saba counties through free digital literacy and communication workshops.
- Increase broadband availability and speeds in Lampasas and San Saba counties through strategic partnerships.
