#### Rural Public Health Workforce Training Network (RPHWTN) Program

The purpose of this program is to expand public health capacity by supporting health care job development, training and placement in rural and tribal communities. The expected impact of this program is to enhance clinical and operational capacity in order to adequately address the population health needs of rural communities affected by COVID-19. The RPHWTN program addresses the ongoing critical need in health care facilities for trained public health professionals serving rural communities. This is done through the establishment of networks to develop formal training/certification programs in order to help professionals in different workforce training tracks. \$47,895,000 will go towards funding the program. There is no award floor or ceiling. Application Deadline: Mar 18, 2022

### Funding Opportunities

#### USDA Rural Energy Pilot Program

Funding from the REPP grant can be used to support community energy planning, capacity building, technical assistance, efficiency, and more. The grant term is for three years, and successful applicants may receive up to 80% of total eligible project costs, not to exceed \$2 million. Eligible applicants to this program are Rural Energy Community Partnerships comprised of non-profit, state, or municipalities. Application Deadline: Feb.4, 2022
