**Texas Workforce Commission Jobs and Education for
Texans (JET) Grant Program**

The JET grant program provides \$16 million to go towards grants to public community, state and technical colleges, school districts, and open-enrollment charter schools to purchase and install equipment necessary for the development of career and technical education courses or programs that lead to a license, certificate, or postsecondary degree in a high-demand occupation. The JET Advisory Board will meet at least once each quarter, or as needed, to review received applications and recommend grant awards.

USDOT RAISE Program

USDOT's Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Program invested \$1.5 billion for FY 2022 for surface transportation infrastructure project investments that have a significant local or regional impact. RAISE can fund port and freight rail projects, and provide capital funding directly to any public entity. The minimum grant award is \$5 million, and \$1 million for projects located in rural areas. Grants may not exceed \$25 million. The Federal cost share may not exceed 80 percent unless the project is located in a rural area.
