**SAM.gov Unique Identity ID**

In April, 2022, the System for Award Management (SAM.gov) will phase out the Dun & Bradstreet (D&B) Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) nine-digit number as the unique identifier for entities throughout the federal awarding lifecycle, and transition to a new unique entity identifier for federal awards management, including, but not limited to, contracts, grants, and cooperative agreements.
