Funding Opportunities

TxCDBG: Downtown Revitalization Program—Program Year 2022

The DRP program objective is to provide infrastructure improvements to address the conditions that contribute to the deterioration in an area designated as slum or blighted in the applicant community's downtown or main street area. Eligible applicants must be an incorporated municipality and not be designated as an official Texas Historical Commission Main Street City. Award amounts are \$250,000 to \$500,000, and the deadline to apply is July 8, 2022.

TxCDBG: Fire Ambulance and Service Truck (FAST) Fund – Program Year 2022

The Fire, Ambulance, & Service Truck (FAST) Fund provides funds for eligible vehicles to provide emergency response and special services to rural communities. Eligible applicants are non-entitlement cities and counties; Non-entitlement cities are located predominately in rural areas and have populations less than 50,000, and for counties less than 200,000 people. Award amounts are \$50,000-\$750,000. The application deadline is July 29, 2022.
