**Department of Health and Human Services Rural Residency Planning and Development (RRPD) Program**

This program provides start-up funding to RRPD award recipients to create new rural residency programs that will ultimately be sustainable long-term through viable and stable funding mechanisms, such as, Medicare, Medicaid, and other public or private funding sources. Rural residencies are accredited allopathic and osteopathic physician residency programs that primarily train residents in rural training sites for greater than 50 percent of their total time in residency. Eligible applicants are public, nonprofit, or private organizations, including rural hospitals, rural community-based ambulatory patient care centers, and institutes of higher education. Awards are up to \$750,000 over three years of performance with no match.

**Funding Opportunities**

**HUD Choice Neighborhoods Implementation Grant Program**

This Program supports the implementation of comprehensive neighborhood revitalization plans that are expected to achieve the following three goals:

1. Housing: Replace distressed public and assisted housing with high-quality mixed-income housing that is well-managed;
2. People: Improve outcomes of households living in the target housing related to employment and income, health, and children's education; and
3. Neighborhood: Create the conditions necessary for public and private reinvestment in distressed neighborhoods to offer the kinds of amenities and assets, including safety, good schools, and commercial activity.

Eligible applicants include city or township governments and public housing authorities. Eligible neighborhoods must be at least 15% below poverty line. Grant max is \$50 million with at least 5% cost share. For More Information and to apply, [Click Here!](#)
