Did You Know?

USDA's Rural Energy for America Program (REAP)

This Program provides guaranteed loan financing and grant funding to agricultural producers and rural small businesses for renewable energy systems or to make energy efficiency improvements. Businesses must be in located in rural areas with populations of 50,000 residents or less. Examples of energy improvements include:

- High efficiency HVAC.
- Insulation.

Loan and loan-grant guarantees are up to 75% of eligible project costs. Grants are for up to 25% of eligible project costs. Applications due Mar.31, 2023. For more information and to apply, Click Here!
